This information is gleaned from more than 100 publications. Some of it as far back as 1950 BC (before computers).

Newly Available: CIMZIA injection indicated in moderately-to-severely active **CROHN'S** disease.

PATANASE aqueous nasal spray for seasonal allergic **RHINITIS**.

From Glaxo: **TREXIMET** (sumatriptan + naproxen) to treat acute **MIGRAINE**.

DUREZOL, a topical steroid to treat postoperative **OCULAR INFLAMATION** and **PAIN**.

PrandiMet (repaglinide + metformin) as an adjunct to diet and exercise in **type 2 diabetes**.

RELISTOR (methylnaltrexone) injection for treating opioid induced **constipation**. (Compounded oral **LOW DOSE NALTREXONE** does also; can be included in the opioid capsules).

NSAID IMPACT on HOSPITALIZATION: Especially in patients taking medicines for diabetes mellitus, hypertension, and diuretics, incidence of hospitalization in patients also taking NSAID's increased by 30 patients per 1,000 patients

What's In a Name? Painkillers are literally killing patients. Acetaminophen, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, etc. increase the risk of developing high blood pressure. Women taking more than 500mg, of Tylenol daily have a 93% greater risk of developing high blood pressure within 3 years. Taking more than 400mg. a day of Motrin increased risk of BP 60%. Dr. Sinatra advises taking **TRAUMEEL**, a homeopathic tablet.

Supplements recommended by Dr Sinatra for patients with high blood pressure: (In addition to prescribed treatments).

CoQ10, 200 mg. daily; D-Ribose, 5 Grams twice a day; Magnesium Glycinate 600mg., 2 or 3 daily; L-carnitine 1.5 Grams twice daily

Examples of Compounded (Customized) Prescriptions of Potential Interest:

Cidofovir 0.5% Solution/Ointment.

Ticlopidine 250 mg. capsules.

Nalbuphine 1.2% ophthalmic analgesic drops, tissue studies (no eye discomfort) ongoing at Ohio U. Made possible by a \$40,000 grant from Prescription Center. **Recent published study used Nalbuphine in an unbuffered solution of bacteriatic saline which is obviously irritating.** Nalbuphine ophthalmic causes discomfort in dry eyes. If needed use a drop of "tears" first

Wisdom is hard work.

Famcyclovir transdermal gel.

Apomorphine Injection, soluble tablets. (Not a controlled substance).

E D T A Gel, 1%, 2%, 3% Etc.

Thyroid Capsules, porcine, same active ingredient as **Armor** tablets, no sugar or aluminum.

Dermatology Prescription, Cream to treat ROSACEA: Disp 30 Grams.

Azelaic Acid 15%, aLipoic Acid 10%, Niacin 4%, Metronidazole-B 1%. Sig: Rub into affected area twice a day. External Use. Not for the Eye.

Commercially made **MEXILETINE 150mg, etc.** is not available. Chemical for compounding is in stock.

Q: Is homeopathic medicine safe?

In the US usage is increasing. Very few homeopathic drugs require a prescription. Rarely do they cause a reaction or conflict with diet or/and other meds. Examples of homeopathic drugs: PSY-stabil for anxiety/ stress; Ricura for rhinitis/sinusitis; Apo-Stom for proper stomach function; co-Hypert for

hypertension; R74 for involuntary urination; R41 for male loss of libido; PMS Formula, Colds & Flu Formula, Migraine Formula; Menopause Formula; R32 for excess/offensive body sweat; Fever Reducing Formula; R54 for inability to concentrate, especially in the elderly. Most Formulas cost \$20 to \$25.00 although safe and usually effective homeopathic drugs are not to replace conventional therapy in chronic situations and are to be used under supervision of your health care provider.
