Here "they" Go Again" AURALGAN eardrops, available before FDA approval of drugs was required, as was aspirin, has added ingredients and is charging \$150 per Rx instead of the typical \$12 for the generic, which is as effective. The new AURALGAN contains acetic acid, as an antifungal and U-polynomial 410 instead of alcohol. The revised product has not received FDA approval. Pharmacists are receiving daily fax (threats) if the generic is used.

Psoriasis, Naturally: A 71-year-old experienced 80% relief from psoriasis by adding olives to his diet. Patients with psoriasis should eat plenty of vegetables, omega-3-rich fish and go easy on meat. The spice curcumin helps. As psoriasis drugs cause nutritional deficiencies, a good daily nutritional supplement is essential. Blood levels should be checked for vitamin D and sun exposure helps. The Blue Cap formula, which originally contained steroids, can be compounded to include steroids. Topical vitamins B-12, B-6 is helpful. Prebiotics/Probiotics taken orally may eliminate mild cases. New Vernal Conjunctivitis Drug: Results of a phase III trial of a cyclosporine A product, Vekacis 0.05% and 0.01% showed both potencies of the drug improved objective signs of VKC and keratitis more effectively than the vehicle. (Approval of Restasis was denied 3 times due to equal effectiveness of the vehicle and the drug. The fourth and approved application did not show superiority). -Modern Medicine.

Drug-Free Therapies for Stomach Distress: PPIs such as Prilosec, Nexium-the purple pill, Prevacid, etc are powerful, expensive drugs that reduce stomach acid. Approved for use for not more than 6 months they are promoted and used for years. Stomach acid is needed to destroy swallowed bacteria, and for the absorption of calcium and vitamin B-12. The effectiveness of Plavix taken to prevent stroke is reduced by PPIs and if taken during pregnancy PPIs increase the chance of asthma in the infant. Alternates: Zinc Carnosine 75-150 mg/day, DGL (licorice) 2 tablets before meals, and digestive enzymes. Suzanne Somers advises Mastic Gum

Examples of Compounded (Customized) Prescriptions of Historical Interest:

Butt paste for diaper rash, cholestyramine 25 Gm, mineral oil 30ml, Triple Paste 454 Gram. <>> Testosterone 25 mg/ml, 4 drops under tongue every 4 hours as needed for energy boost in males, and 1 or 2 hours before sex. >> not for testosterone replacement. <>> For male replacement, testosterone almond oil suspension, 200mg/cc, 10 drops in the AM, 5 drops PM, applied to the forearm at bedtime. Estradiol, 5mg per ml, 1 drop under tongue for menstrual headache. <>>

Clomiphene Konstant (sustained release) 25 mg capsules given at bedtime 3 times a week to increase testosterone production. <>> Testosterone Cypionate 100mg/ml IM 40 mg given sub-q, above the wallet twice a week. <>> For fibromyalgia, Iodine 100mg, vit B-2 300 mg, niacin (flush) 1000 mg. <>> Bed sore treatment, sucralfate 4%, metronidazole 2% in m-cellulose 2%. <>> 3% testosterone cream applied topically to the eye lids for dry eyes. Especially helpful for postmenopausal women. <>> For fibromyalgia, 15 to 30 Grams a day of D-Ribose. <>> Deoxy-d-glucose, cimetidine, tea tree oil, and ibuprofen for warts.
